Application Procedure

Application Requirements: The following items are required for the processing of a student's application for admission to Jacksonville College:

- Application:** Please type or print the Application for Admission.
- Application Fee:** There is a \$15.00 non-refundable fee to process the application (must be paid before institutional scholarship applications will be reviewed).
- Transcript:** Official High School Transcript (showing graduation date) or proof of General Educational Development (G.E.D.) completion or official transcripts from all colleges/universities previously attended.
- Social Security Card:** Submit a copy of the social security card.
- Photograph:** Submit a small, recent photograph (or clear photocopy).
- Medical History Form** (fall and spring semesters only): Must submit a completed Medical History Form with either a doctor's signature or an immunization record.
- Test Scores:** Students who have taken an ACT, SAT or TASP should submit official scores. A Jacksonville College Placement Exam may be required. This test covers reading, writing and algebra.

Financial Aid Requirements: Students who desire to apply for Federal Pell Grants, Texas Tuition Equalization Grants, Jacksonville College Awards or Scholarships, or any other Federal/State monies must have the following on file:

- FAFSA:** Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This form is available in the Admissions Office or may be submitted online.
- Scholarship/Award Application:** Complete and return an institutional scholarship/award application.
- Jacksonville College Application for Financial Aid/Oath of Residency:** The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board requires each student receiving financial aid to provide substantiating documentation to affirm residence.

Students who complete the FAFSA by August 1 (for fall semester enrollment) will receive priority consideration for financial aid. Each male student must complete the FAFSA questions concerning Selective Service, or his form will not be processed.

Housing Reservation: For students desiring on-campus housing, a residence hall application is required along with an \$80.00 (\$75.00 for room and \$5.00 key) deposit. This deposit may be refunded upon departure.

Registration Requirements: At the time of registration, the student must also pay \$50.00 toward his/her account as well as the cost of his/her textbooks because money for financial aid and institutional scholarships/awards will not be available until later in the semester.
